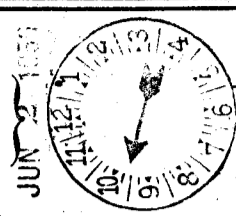

SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Hoyt Turner

in and by My certain Promissory note in writing, of even date with these

Presents, as well and truly indebted to Elmer P. Edwards

in the full and just sum of Two Hundred & No/100 (\$200.00)

, to be paid As follows, Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per month until interest and principal is paid in full.

, with interest thereon from date

at the rate of 7 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid Annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Elmer P. Edwards, his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Oneal Township, about three miles north from Greer, S.C., lying on the west side of the Miller Road, being bounded on the North, West and South by Lands of Mrs Mae Waters and on the east by said road, and being part of the same tract of land that was conveyed to Mrs. Mae Waters by deed from J.H. Waters April 10th 1919, recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 44 at page 485, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

BEGINNING on a nail in the center of the said Miller Road at a point about half way between South Tiger River and the Gap Creek Road, and run thence N. 69-15 W. 30 feet to an iron pin on the west bank of the said road, then continuing with the same course for a total distance of 250 feet to an iron Pin; thence S. 43-40 W. 190 feet to an iron Pin; thence S. 69-15 E. 250 feet to a nail in the center of the said road (Iron pin back on line at 32 feet); thence with center of the said road, N. 43-40 E. 190 feet to the beginning corner, containing One (1) Acre more or less.
