TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

FRED THOMAS AND ANNIE THOMAS (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

Five Hundred and No/100 - - - - -
DOLLARS (\$ 500.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of **six (6%)** per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying on the eastern side of Richland Creek and fronting on Mount Zion Avenue and designated as Lot 19 on a plat of Richland Hill by F. G. Rogers dated February 1911 recorded in Plat Book C at Page 99, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a point on the western side of Mount Zion Avenue which point is 240 feet from the intersection of Mount Zion Avenue with Church Street and running thence with the line of Lot 20 N. 82 1/2 W. 118 feet to point on a 10 feet alley adjoining Richland Creek; thence with the eastern line of said alley N. 1 1/2 E. 50 feet to a point; thence along the line of Lot 18 S. 82 E. 119 feet to a point on the western side of Mount Zion Avenue; thence with the western side of said avenue S. 3 1/2 W. 48 feet to the point of beginning.

Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagors by deed recorded in Deed Book 551 at Page 129.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
