ALL those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land with buildings and improvements thereon situate in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as LOT NO. 116 and LOT NO. 32 as shown on plat thereof recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "G", at pages 152-155 and having a frontage of 200 feet on Marion Road and described as follows:

LOT NO. 32: BEGINNING at a pin on the North side of Marion Road (formerly Nichols Street) at corner of Lott 33 and running thence along line of Lot 33, 413 feet to a pin on branch; thence with said branch in a Northeasterly direction 170 feet 8 inches to a pin, corner of Lot 31; thence South 455 feet, 5 inches to a pin on Marion Road at corner of Lot 28; thence with said road 100 feet to the beginning corner.
