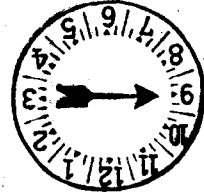

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being in Glassy Mountain  
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina having the following  
description, known as a part of the Robert Parker land:

BEGINNING at the old Sourwood corner and running thence S. 36.45 W. 198  
feet to an iron pin; thence N. 60.00 W. 755 feet to a stake; thence N.  
40.15 E. 50 feet to a stake; thence N. 52.00 W. 418 feet to a stake;  
Thence N. 65.00 W. 10 feet to a stake near the branch above the water  
falls; thence N. 65.00 W. 50 feet to a stake; thence S. 18.30 W. 100  
feet to a stake; thence N. 86.30 W. 300 feet to an iron pin on the  
West side of a road; thence N. 64.30 W. 304 feet to a stone on the  
West bank of a small branch, the Will Parker corner; thence with his  
line N. 15.30 W. 522 feet to a stone, Green's corner; thence N. 15.30  
W. 29 feet to a stake on the old line; thence with same line. S. 58.45  
W. 2178 feet to the BEGINNING corner, containing nine acres more or less.
