I, Walter A. Tumblin

SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Walter A. Tumblin
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these
Presents, am well and truly indebted to B. C. Givens
in the full and just sum of Three Thousand - - - - -

, to be paid as follows: \$100.00 November 6, 1956 and \$100.00
on the 6th day of each month thereafter until paid in full

, with interest thereon from date
at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage
in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises
to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to
the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bar-
gained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said B. C.
Givens his Heirs and Assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying, being and situate in the
County and State aforesaid, Dunklin Township, containing one (1) acre,
more or less, according to a plat and survey made by E. E. Gary, Surveyor,
April 8, 1948, with the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning
at an iron pin in the eastern edge of the Dunklin Bridge Road, joint
corner with lands of J. L. Sims, running thence along the line of said
J. L. Sims N. 64 E. 3.16 to an iron pin; thence S. 19 3/4 E. 3.16 to
an iron pin; thence S. 64 W. 3.16 to an iron pin in the eastern edge
of said Dunklin Bridge Road; thence with said road N. 19-3/4 W. 3.16 to
an iron pin, the point of beginning, bounded by Dunklin Bridge Road on
the West, lands of Alvin Sims across said road, and other lands of the
said J. L. Sims. This being the same lot of land upon which is located
a frame cottage dwelling occupied by me.
