TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, **William A. Hammond**

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of **Six Thousand and No/100-** - - - - -

**DOLLARS (\$6000.00**), with interest thereon from date at the rate of **Six (6%)** per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Northwest intersection of Marion Road, and Cottingham Circle, near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as lot # 59, on plat of Monaghan Subdivision prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated August 9, 1954, recorded in Plat Book GG at Pages 86 and 87, according to said plat being more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Cottingham Circle, at the joint front corner of lots # 58 and 59, and running thence with the line of said lots S. 11-14 E. 97.1 feet to an iron pin, at the joint rear corner of lots # 48, 58 and 59; thence with line of lot # 48, S. 48-04 E. 110 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of Marion Road; thence with the Northwest side of said road, N. 41-46 E. 35 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing N. 41-46 E. 75 feet, more or less, to a point, near the intersection of Marion Road and Cottingham Circle; thence with the curve of said intersection, the chord of which is N. 3-14 W. 35.4 feet to a point on the Western side of Cottingham Circle; thence with the curve of the western side of said Circle, the chord of which is N. 48-14 W. 25 feet to a point; thence continuing with the curve of the Western side of said Circle, the chord of which is N. 75-51 W. 156.3 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner."

Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by J. P. Stevens & Co. by deed to be recorded herewith.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
