BEGINNING at a point in the center of the said Pelzer Road, (stone on East Bank of Road, and running thence with the Chandler line S. 15-20 E. 32.9 feet to a stone; thence S. 15-20 E. 484 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 87-30 W. with the W.W.
