SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said W. L. Burger  
 in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these  
 Presents, am well and truly indebted to H. K. Townes, Attorney  
 in the full and just sum of Forty-one Hundred and no/100 (\$4100.00) Dollars  
 , to be paid 90 days from date

, with interest thereon from date  
 at the rate of 7 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly  
 until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear  
 interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,  
 the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
 may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the  
 hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof  
 necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage  
 in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises  
 to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to  
 the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bar-  
 gained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
 H. K. Townes, Attorney, his heirs and assigns:

ALL that lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina being shown  
 as Lot #69 on plat made for Arrowood and Burger by J. Mac Richardson and  
 being shown as Lot #69 and a portion of lot #70 according to a plat of the  
 property of Eliza T. Looper made by R. E. Dalton in 1924 and revised in  
 1947 and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a pin at the joint front corner of Lots #68 and #69, (as  
 shown by the Richardson and Dalton plats) and running thence with the  
 eastern side of Washington Avenue, N. 22-00 W. 41.5 feet to the curve  
 of the intersection of a new cut street and Washington Avenue; thence  
 with the curve of said intersection 56 feet, more or less, to a pin on  
 the southern side of the new cut street; thence with the southern side  
 of the new cut street, N. 68-00 E. 125 feet to a pin; thence S. 22-00 E.  
 66.5 feet to joint rear corner of lots #68 and #69; thence with the line  
 of lot #68, S. 68 W. 150 feet to the beginning corner.
