# MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Willis G. Wellmon

Greenville, S. C. , hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

Aiken Loan & Security Company , a corporation  
organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina , hereinafter  
called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which  
are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Eleven Thousand Five Hundred  
Dollars (\$ 11,500.00 ), with interest from date at the rate of five ----- per centum  
( 5 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of  
Aiken Loan & Security Company in Florence, South Carolina ,  
or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of  
Sixty-seven and 28/100 - - - - - Dollars (\$ 67.28 ),  
commencing on the first day of May , 19 57, and on the first day of each month there-  
after until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest,  
if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of April , 19 82.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better  
securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three  
Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing  
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained,  
sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its  
successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville ,  
State of South Carolina:

All that lot of land in the city of Greenville, county of Greenville,  
state of South Carolina, being a portion of Lot No. 76 on plat of  
Isaqueena Park subdivision, recorded in Plat Book P, pages 130-131,  
R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., and having according to  
said plat prepared by R. W. Dalton, March, 1957, the following metes  
and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of DuPont Drive, the joint  
corner of Lots Nos. 104 and 76; thence with the south side of DuPont  
Drive S. 83-24 W. 102 feet to an iron pin; thence through lot No. 76  
S. 16-22 W. 137 feet to an iron pin on the northerly side of Harrington  
Avenue; thence with the northerly side of said Harrington Avenue,  
S. 63-03 E. 70 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 77; thence with  
the line of Lot No. 77 and Lot No. 104, N. 23-31 E. 190.3 feet to the  
beginning corner.
