All of that parcel or lot of land in the City of Greer, in Chick Springs Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on the South side of the U. S. Dual Lane Highway No. 29, bounded on the North by said highway, on the East by lands reserved by Nancy W. Finley, on the South by Don Owens and possibly others, and on the West by E. H. Edwards and Mrs. J. C. Cunningham, having the following courses and distances:

Beginning on an iron pin on the right-of-way of said highway, corner with E. H. Edwards--formerly Burnett property--and runs thence with line of E. H. Edwards and Mrs. J. C. Cunningham S. 0.56 E. 137 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 79.24 E. 50.25 feet to a point; thence a new line N. 0.56 W. 141.89 feet to a point on the right-of-way of said highway; thence with the right-of-way of said highway N. 85.01 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
