property conveyed to P. D. Jarrard by Thomas T. Goldsmith. Having  
the following metes and bounds, according to plat and survey made by  
W. A. Hester, L. S. on August 26th, 1947.

BEGINNING at an iron pin on road and running thence N. 57 W. 3.00  
chains to iron pin; thence S. 32 W. 2.00 chains to iron pin, joint
