To All Whom These Presents May Concern

I, WILLIAM C. BRYANT

hereinafter spoken of as the Mortgagor send greeting.

Whereas WILLIAM C. BRYANT

is justly indebted to C. Douglas Wilson & Co., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter spoken of as the Mortgagee, in the sum of

Ten Thousand Five Hundred - - - - - Dollars

(\$ 10,500.00), lawful money of the United States which shall be legal tender in payment of all debts and dues, public and private, at the time of payment, secured to be paid by that one certain note or obligation, bearing even date herewith, conditioned for payment at the principal office of the said C. Douglas Wilson & Co., in the City of Greenville, S. C., or at such other place either within or without the State of South Carolina, as the owner of this obligation may from time to time designate, of the sum of

Ten Thousand Five Hundred - - - - - Dollars (\$ 10,500.00)

with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of $5 \frac{3}{4}$ per centum per annum, said interest to be paid on the first day of June 19 57 and thereafter said interest and principal sum to be paid in installments as follows: Beginning on the first day of July 19 57, and on the first day of each month thereafter the sum of \$ 66.07 to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to and including the first day of May 19 82, and the balance of said principal sum to be due and payable on the first day of June 19 82; the aforesaid monthly payments of \$ 66.07 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate of $5 \frac{3}{4}$ per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 10,500 or so much thereof as shall from time to time remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal. Said principal and interest to be paid at the par of exchange and net to the obligee, it being thereby expressly agreed that the whole of the said principal sum shall become due after default in the payment of interest, taxes, assessments, water rate or insurance, as hereinafter provided.

Now, Know All Men, that the said Mortgagor in consideration of the said debt and sum of money mentioned in the condition of the said note and for the better securing the payment of the said sum of money mentioned in the condition of the said note with the interest thereon, and also for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid by the said Mortgagee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, conveyed and released and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, convey and release unto the said Mortgagee and to its successors, legal representatives and assigns, forever, all that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the county of Greenville, state of South Carolina, on the southwest side of Crestline Road, and having according to a revised plat made by Piedmont Engineering Service, October 26, 1951 and a recent survey made May 1957 by R. W. Dalton, Engineer, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southwest side of Crestline Road corner of property now or formerly of Moseley; thence with the line of said property S. 52-58 W. 243.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 46-45 E. 193.1 feet to a point in the center of a branch; thence with the center of said branch as the line, the traverse line of which is N. 37-24 E. 86 feet to a point; thence N. 65-10 E. 90 feet to a point; thence N. 47-46 E. 56.7 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of Crestline Road; thence with the southwest side of Crestline Road N. 41-59 W. 176.7 feet to the beginning corner.
