TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

GERALD C. TWITTY (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto CAROLINA FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, Greenville, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Fifteen Thousand One Hundred and no/100 -----  
DOLLARS (\$15,100.00 ), with interest thereon from date at the rate of five and one-half (5½) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, and

WHEREAS, the unpaid balance of said debt or debts, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable,

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being at the Northern intersection of Pine Creek Drive and Marlboro Drive, in Gantt Township, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 270 as shown on a plat prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated March 28, 1956, entitled "Plat of Belle Meade, Section 3" and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG at page 187, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Pine Creek Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 270 and 271, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 271 N. 38-30 E. 105 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 289 S. 65-48 E. 89.3 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Marlboro Drive; thence with the Western side of Marlboro Drive S. 13-36 W. 67.4 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the Western side of Marlboro Drive, S. 17-30 W. 46.1 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Pine Creek Drive and Marlboro Drive, the chord of which is S. 72-53 W. 28.3 feet to an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Pine Creek Drive; thence with the Northeastern side of Pine Creek Drive, N. 51-30 W. 116.1 feet to the point of beginning.
