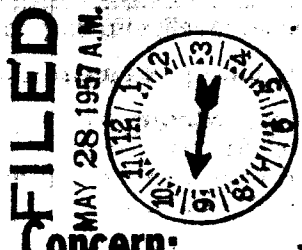

at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Pelzer-Williamston Bank, its successors and assigns forever;

All that piece, parcel of lot of land with improvements thereon in Oak Lawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the western side of Augusta Road, some eighteen miles below the City of Greenville, and being a portion of T. Irving Campbell property, a plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book CC at page 183, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the western side of the Augusta Road at the point front corner of 28.07 acres owned by T. Irving Campbell, property now or formerly owned by J. R. Putman, and running thence 370 ft. with said line to a point; thence S. 31-45 E. 50 ft. to a point; thence N. 76-30 E. approximately 370 ft. to a point on Augusta Road, also known as Highway No. 25; thence with Highway 25, N. 41-20 W. 50 ft. to the point of beginning.

This being that same lot of land conveyed to me by T. Irving Campbell by his deed dated October 9, 1952, and recorded in the Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 464, page 361.
