SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said Francis W. Bonner

in and by a certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to General Mortgage Co.

in the full and just sum of One Thousand and no/100ths- (\$ 1,000.00) DOLLARS, to be paid at its offices in Greenville, S. C., together with

interest thereon from date hereof until maturity at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest being payable in monthly installments as follows:

Beginning on the 1st day of August, 1957, and on the 1st day of each succeeding month of each year thereafter the sum of \$ 86.07, to be applied on the

interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to and including the 1st day of June,

1958, and the balance of said principal and interest to be due and payable on the 1st day of July,

1958; the aforesaid monthly payments of \$ 86.07 each are to be applied first to

interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 1,000.00 or

so much thereof as shall, from time to time, remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal.

All installments of principal and all interest are payable in lawful money of the United States of America; and in the event default is made in the payment of any installment or installments, or any part hereof, as therein provided, the same shall bear simple interest from the date of such default until paid at the rate of seven (7%) per centum per annum.

And if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, or if default be made in respect to any condition, agreement or covenant contained herein, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including (10%) per cent, of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said General Mortgage Co. according

it, the said General Mortgage Co.

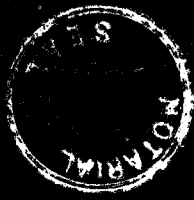

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of South Warwick Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 80 and 81, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 80 S. 42-10 E. 240 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 70; thence with the rear line of Lots Nos. 70 and 69, S. 44-39 W. 267.2 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 68; thence with the line of Lots Nos. 68 and 82 N. 30-00 W. 327.3 feet to an iron pin on the Southeastern side of South Warwick Road; thence with the Southeastern side of South Warwick Road N. 71-21 E. 110 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the Southeastern side of South Warwick Road N. 60-03 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
