AFFIDAVIT

PERSONALLY appeared before me William D. Young, who first being duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

The within mortgage was originally executed in favor of W. E. Freeman, individually, and William A. Clineburg and Arthur C. Kingston, Jr., as Trustees for Nancy Lou Young, Betty Jane Shorey, and Jean Young Martin, under three separate trust agreements, by and between deponent and said trustees, dated June 1, 1945. Pursuant to the terms of such agreements, the Trustees had power to select and appoint a third person to serve with them as co-trustee, and also had the privilege of resigning as co-trustees by serving written notice of intention to do so upon the other co-trustees who thereupon had power to select and appoint another individual to serve with him or them. Thereafter, the said Arthur C. Kingston, Jr. and William A. Clineburg selected and appointed Thomas B. Taylor to serve with them as co-trustee. Pursuant to agreements dated April 30, 1951, the said Arthur C. Kingston, Jr., William A. Clineburg, and Thomas B. Taylor resigned as co-trustees under the trust agreements first above mentioned, and elected as their successors Dorothy R. Young, Gregory Shorey, Jr., and Charles Martin, who are now the active trustees.
