Bouchillon and Jean Inman Black Bouchillon in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Hubert E. Nolin, his heirs and assigns forever,

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land with buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 28 on the West side of King Street as shown by plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engrs. in June 1941 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at page 11.

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of King Street at the joint front corner of Lots 27 and 28 and running thence along King Street, North 1-36 West 50 feet to an iron pin; running thence South 88-31 West 137.7 feet to an iron pin; running thence South 1-36 East 50 feet to an iron pin; running thence North 88-31 East 136.8 feet to an iron pin on King Street, the beginning corner.
