SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Dorothy T. Bacle
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these

at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually, in
advance until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof
