

Thence S. 51 1/2 W. 31.50 chains to a stake; thence N. 84 W. 17.20 chains to a stone; thence S. 64 1/2 W. 7.40 chains to a Spanish Oak; the beginning corner, as appears from a plat made by J. E. Sirrine, May 26th, 1909, and containing 314.77 acres, more or less.

From the above tract should be deducted five acres conveyed to M. M. Tankersley. Also 4.25 acres conveyed to W. B. McCarron on Nov. 11, 1955.
