ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, South Carolina situate lying and being on the northern side of Montclair Avenue (formerly Fairview Avenue) and being known and designated as Lot 3 of Block K of a subdivision known as Highland Terrace, plat of which is recorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office in Plat Book K at pages 120-121-122, and having such metes and bounds as shown thereon.
