All its right, title and interest, the same being a one-third undivided interest, in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, consisting of 54 acres, more or less, lying, situate and being about 3-1/2 miles from Greenville County Courthouse on what is known as Piney Mountain, and having the following metes and bounds:
