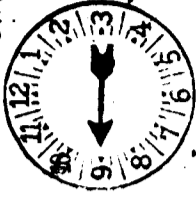

SEND GREETING:

I, Elma T. Culbertson
Whereas, I, the said Elma T. Culbertson
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these
Presents, am well and truly indebted to Farmers Bank of Simpsonville
in the full and just sum of Four Hundred Seventeen and No/100 -- Dollars
, to be paid on July 5, 1958

, with interest thereon from date
at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually, in
advance until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage
in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises
to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to
the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, lying and being in
Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near
the Village of Mauldin, Containing 7.64 acres, more or less, and
being designated on a plat thereof as made by C. O. Riddle, Surveyor,
under date of January 8, 1954 as lot No. 5. It begins in the center
of the intersection of a country road known as the Brooks road and
a new county road and runs thence N. 87-50 W. 29.5 ft. to iron pin
on the western bank of a new county road; thence N. 87-50 W. 926.5
feet to iron pin; thence N. 43-46 W. 642 feet to iron pin on lands
of Hugh Cox; thence along Cox line S. 20-45 W. 235.7 feet to a
Stone; thence S. 38-30 E. 56 feet to iron pin; thence N. 19 E.
100 ft. to iron pin; thence S. 50 E. 1270 ft. more or less to corner
in center of Brooks Road; thence along that road N. 37-50 E. 228 ft.
to bend; thence N. 44-35 E. 431.8 feet to the beginning corner, and
