T. Witcher, his heirs and assigns: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, situate, lying and being on the west side of North Main Street, being known and designated as all of Lot No. 14 and the northern half of lot No. 15 on plat of North Park made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May, 1940, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book K. pages 48 and 49, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of North Main Street, the joint corner of lots Nos. 13 and 14; and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 70-14 W. 160 feet to an iron pin thence S. 19-46 W. 90 feet to an iron pin in the center of the rear line of lot No. 15; thence with the center of lot No. 15, S. 70-14 E. 160 feet to an iron pin on the west side of North Main Street; thence with the west side of North Main Street, N. 19-46 E. 90 feet to the beginning corner.
