I, J. T. GILBERT

SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said J. T. Gilbert

hereinafter called the mortgagor(s)

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to J. B. HALL

hereinafter called the mortgagee(s), in the full and just sum of Two Thousand Two Hundred Fifty and no/100 ----- DOLLARS (\$ 2,250.00 ), to be paid

\$24.98 on the 11th day of April 1958, and a like amount on the 11th day of each and every month thereafter until the entire principal sum is paid in full; said installments to be applied first to the payment of interest and the balance to principal; balance due 10 years from date

, with interest thereon from date

at the rate of six (6%) percentum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly
