

SEND GREETING:

Presents. well and truly indebted to Citizens Lumber Company, a corporation in the full and just sum of FIVE THOUSAND AND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$5500.00)

Dollars , to be paid \$55.00 120 days from date and \$55.00 each succeeding month thereafter until paid in full, with payments to be to be paid \$55.00 120 days from date and \$55.00 each applied first to the semi-annual interest and then to the principal

, with interest thereon from 90 days after date

at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid

semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

gained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Lumber Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns:

ALL that lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina known and designated as Lot #22 on Crestmore Drive ina subdivision known as Grand-View, as shown by a plat thereof made by Woodward Engineering Company, March, 1957, and recorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office in Plat Book "KK", at page 93, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a pin on the southern side of Crestmore Drive at the joint front corner of Lots # 23 and #22 and running thence with the southern side of Crestmore Drive, N. 74-17 E., 60 feet to a pin at the corner of Lot #21; thence with the line of Lot #21, S. 15-43 E., 154.2 feet to a pin in the rear line of Lot #12; thence with the rear lines of Lots #12 and #11, S. 72-35 W., 60.02 feet to a pin in the rear corner of Lot #23; thence with the line of Lot #23, $\bar{\text{N}}$. 15-43 W., 156 feet to the point of beginning.
