NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of **Greenville**, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying on the southeastern intersection of Carter Drive with Henderson Drive near the City of Greenville, being shown as lot 28, on a plat of Laurel Heights, recorded in Plat Book KK at Page 33, being more particularly shown on a plat of the property of Henry C. Harding prepared by R. W. Dalton, and according to said plat being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Carter Drive at front corner of lot 38; and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 89-34 E. 125.4 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of lot 29; thence with the line of said lot, N. 25-44 W. 186.1 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Henderson Drive; thence with the southern side of Henderson Drive, S. 64-16 W. 13.6 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Henderson Drive with Carter Drive, the chord of which is S. 33-56 W. 43.1 feet to an iron pin on the southeastern side of Carter Drive; thence with the southeastern side of said Drive, S. 3-36 W. 125 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagor by deed to be recorded.

Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
