reference, in the sum of Six Thousand Two Hundred Fifty and No/100

DOLLARS (\$ 6,250.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Town of Fountain Inn, being known and designated as Lot No. 9 on Nash Street in accordance with plat of L. F. Armstrong property made by L.C. Godsey, September 23, 1954 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and being more particularly described in accordance with said plat, to-wit:
