WHEREAS I, James E. Burger

am well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of NINE THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$9,000.00) Dollars, in and by my certain promissory note in writing of even date herewith, due and payable on the day of 19

to be paid \$90.00 120 days from date and \$90.00 each succeeding month thereafter until paid in full, with payments to be applied first to the interest and then to the principal

with interest from 90 days after date at the rate of six per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid semi-annually and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said James E. Burger

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Lumber Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns:

ALL those lots of land in Greenville County, South Carolina known and designated as Lots #30 and #31 of a subdivision known as Glendale Heights as shown by a plat thereof made by J. Mac Richardson, February, 1958, and recorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office in Plat Book "KK", at page 143, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a pin on the western side of Glendale Avenue at the corner of Lot #32 and running thence with the western side of Glendale Avenue N. 6-45 W., 120 feet to a pin at the curve of the intersection of Driver Avenue and Glendale Street; thence with the curve of said intersection (traverse is N. 51-45 W., 28.3 feet) to a pin on the southern side of Driver Avenue; thence with the southern side of Driver Avenue, S. 83-15 W., 110 feet to a pin at the rear corner of Lot #66; thence with the rear lines of Lots #66 and #65, S. 6-45 E., 140 feet to a pin at the rear corner of Lot #32; thence with the line of Lot #32, N. 83-15 E., 130 feet to the point of beginning.
