C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to me the said mortgagor... in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, situated on east bank of Enoree River about a half mile north of where the P. & N. railroad crosses said river and in the Cannada community, and having the following metes and bounds:-

BEGINNING at iron pin in the center of a road, thence S. 67 3/4 W. 2.74 chains to iron pin; thence S.  $3\frac{1}{4}$  W. 8.56 chains to a point on east bank of Enoree River; thence down said river 1.28 chains to a point on east bank of said Enoree River; thence 1.47 chains to a walnut tree; thence 2.53 thains to a plow point iron pin; thence 3.25 chains to iron pin in above mentioned road; thence with said road N.  $31\frac{1}{2}$  W. 7.40 chains to beginning corner, and containing four and twenty-five hundredths (4.25) acres, more or less according to survey made by J.
