All that certain property described as follows:

Beginning at a point in Old Appalachian Highway at the southeast corner of lot Number two and running north 19 degrees 18 minutes east with the line of lot Number two, 211.5 feet to a stake in Julian Calhoun's line, and old southern Railroad roadbed; thence with Calhoun's line and old roadbed south 74 degrees 50 minutes east 339.2 feet to an iron pin; thence south 28 degrees 40 minutes west 199.1 feet to a stake in south side of old Appalachian Highway (an iron pin offset in line 29 feet from corner); thence north 77 degrees 40 minutes west 300 feet to the beginning corner, containing 1.47 acres, more or less.
