Whereas, we, the said Hugh I. Jordan and Wife, Jo Elizabeth N. Jordan

in the full and just sum of FIFTEEN THOUSAND and NO/100 DOLLARS (\$15,000.00)
, to be paid by installments of One Hundred Twenty-five
Dollars (\$125.00) per month, first payment due August 1st, 1958 and
on the first day of each and every month thereafter until principal
and interest are paid in full,
, with interest thereon from date hereof

at the rate of five per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage

alley; thence with west side of alley S. 12-00 E. 52 feet to a stake,
