# MORTGAGE

WHEREAS: Bobby Joe Powell

of Greenville, S. C. hereinafter called the Mortgagor, is indebted to Sumner G. Whittier, as Administrator of Veterans' Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America, and his successors in such office, as such, and his or their assigns, hereinafter called Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Fifty-Four Hundred and no/100

Dollars (\$ 5,400.00 ), with interest from date at the rate of four and three-fourths per centum (4-3/4%) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of the Loan Guaranty Officer, Veterans Administration Regional Office, at Columbia, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Thirty and 79/100 Dollars (\$ 30.79 ), commencing on the 22nd day of September, 19 58, and continuing on the 22nd day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the 22nd day of August, 1983.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, and unto his successors in such office, as such, and his or their assigns, the following described property, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the westerly side of Camelot Lane, near the City of Greenville, S. C., and being shown as Lot No. 4 on the plat of property of J. E. Strickland made by J. C. Hill August 6, 1954, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the westerly side of Camelot Lane, joint front corner of Lots 3 and 4, which pin is located 404.2 feet from the westerly corner of the intersection of Camelot Lane with Welcome Road, and running thence along the common line of Lots 3 and 4 N 73-0 W 134.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S 15-56 W 11.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S 37-36 W 62.3 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 4 and 5; thence along the common line of said lots S 73-0 E 156.4 feet to an iron pin on the westerly side of Camelot Lane; thence along the westerly side of said Lane N 17-0 E 70 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

Together with all and singular the improvements thereon and the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining; all the rents, issues, and profits thereof (provided, however, that the Mortgagor shall be entitled to collect and retain the said rents, issues, and profits until default hereunder); all fixtures now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the premises herein described and in addition thereto the following described household appliances, which are and shall be deemed to be, fixtures and a part of the realty and are a portion of the security for the indebtedness herein mentioned;
