SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Ann C. Williams  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing of even date with these  
Presents, am well and truly indebted to Bates Aiken or Julius B. Aiken  
in the full and just sum of Seventy Seven Hundred, Twenty (\$7,720.00) Dollars  
, to be paid on the 3rd day of September, 1960

, with interest thereon from date  
at the rate of 6% per centum per annum, to be computed and paid Annually  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,  
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the

gained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
Bates Aiken or Julius B. Aiken, their respective heirs and assigns forever,

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the County of  
Greenville, State of South Carolina in Paris Mountain Township, containing 1  
acre more or less, situate on the West of S. C. Highway No. 250 and more  
particularly described as follows:
