E. E. Martin (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

DOLLARS (\$ 4,000.00 ), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Greenville Township, known as lot # 3, of subdivision of property owned by Townes & Hartsell, according to plat recorded in the RMC Office for said County in Plat Book G at Page 262, and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a point in Old Paris Mountain Road, corner of lots # 2 and 3, and running thence along the joint line of lots # 2 and 3, N. 71-41 E. 150 feet to point at the joint corner of lots # 2, 3, 6 and 10; thence with the joint line of lots # 3 and 10, S. 18-15 E. 50 feet to a point, corner of lots # 3 and 4; thence with the joint line of lots # 3 and 4, S. 71-45 W. 150 feet to point at corner of lot # 3; in Old Paris Mountain Road; thence along said Old Paris Mountain Road, N. 18-15 W. 50 feet to the beginning.
