NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said J. E. Strickland

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

George F. Townes, as Attorney for the Estate of H. K. Townes, his heirs and assigns:

~~all that tract or lot of land in Township Greenville County, State of South Carolina,~~

ALL that lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina known and designated as Lot #48 of a subdivision known as Spring Brook Terrace, as shown by a plat thereof made by J. Mac Richardson, Surveyor, March, 1958, and recorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office in Plat Book "KK", at page 143, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Miami Avenue at the corner of Lot #49 and running thence with the northern side of Miami Avenue, N. 88-00 E., 30 feet to a pin at the intersection of Miami Avenue and Walton Street; thence with the curve of said intersection (the traverse being N. 43 E., 14.1) feet to a pin on the western side of Walton Street; thence with the western side of Walton Street, N. 2-00 W., 140 feet to a pin in the subdivision property line; thence with the subdivision property line, S. 88-00 W., 100 feet to a pin at the rear corner of Lot #49; thence with the line of Lot #49, S. 2-00 E., 150 feet to the point of beginning.
