bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Frances T. Tindal, William M. Tindal, Jr., Frances T. Mitchell and Henry Tindal
all that tract or lot of land in

Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

on the southwestern side of Thompson Road, being known and designated as Lots Nos.
5 and 6 on a Plat of property of Wm. M. Tindal by C. O. Riddle, Reg. L. S., dated
August 1955 and having, according to said Plat, the following courses and distances,
to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Thompson Road at the joint
corner of Lots 6 and 7 and running thence along the joint line of Lots 6 and 7
and 1, S. 50-28 W. 317.9 feet to an iron pin on line of Lot No. 1; thence along
the rear line of Lots Nos. 2 and 3 N. 39-15 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on a branch;
thence with the branch as the line in the following traverse courses and distances:
N. 20-17 E. 102.9 feet; N. 75-33 E. 187.6 feet to an iron pin; and N. 49-47 E.
89.4 feet to an iron pin on the southwestern side of Thompson Road; thence with
said Road S. 26-57 E. 75.5 feet and S. 31-10 E. 101.1 feet to the point of beginning.
