"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as lot # 7, White Horse Heights, which plat is recorded in the RMC Office in Plat Book BB at Page 135, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the westerly side of Vale Street, joint front corner of lots # 6 and 7, and running thence S. 61-10 W. 190 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots # 6 and 7; thence S. 15-10 E. 80.4 feet to an iron pin joint rear corner of lots # 7 and 8; thence N. 70-42 E. 190.2 feet to an iron pin on Vale Street, joint corner of lots # 7 and 8; thence along Vale Street, N. 19-18 W. 117.2 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
