And said mortgagor agrees to keep the building and improvements now standing or hereafter erected upon the mortgaged premises and any and all appearatus, fixtures and appearatus appearatus and appearatus, fixtures and appearatus are now or hereafter in or attached to said buildings or improvements, insured against loss or damage by fire and such other hazards as the mortgage may from time to time require, all such insurance to be in forms, in companies and in sums (not less than sufficient to avoid any claim on the part of the insurers for co-insurance) satisfactory to the mortgagee; that all insurance policies shall be held by and shall be for the benefit of and first payable in case of loss to the mortgagee, and that at least fifteen days before the expiration of each such policy, a new and sufficient policy to take the place of the one so expiring shall be delivered to the mortgagee. The mortgagor hereby assigns to the mortgagee all moneys recoverable under each such policy, and agrees that in the event of a loss the amount collected under any policy of insurance on said property may; at the option of the mortgagee, be applied by the mortgagee upon any indebtedness and/or obligation secured hereby and in such order as mortgage may determine; or said amount or any portion thereof may, at the option of the mortgagee, either be used in replacing, repairing or restoring the improvements partially or totally destroyed to a condition satisfactory to said mortgagee, or be neleased to the mortgagor in either of which events the mortgagee shall not be obligated to see to the proper application thereof; nor shall the amount so released or used be deemed a payment on any indebtedness secured hereby.
