I, **ALCIDE S. BENINI** of
Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

AIKEN LOAN & SECURITY COMPANY

All that lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 193 on plat of **AUGUSTA ACRES**, recorded in Plat Book **S**, page 201 of the RMC Office for Greenville County, said lot having a frontage on the north side of Meadors Avenue of 100.5 feet, a parallel depth of 221.2 feet, and a rear width of 100.5 feet.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
