All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina being known and designated as Lot No. 89 and a portion of Lot No. 88 as shown on Map #2 of Nickeltown Heights made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, in April 1941 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "M", Page 5 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
