JACK H. McCAULEY (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto CAROLINA FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, Greenville, S. C.; (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Four Thousand Two Hundred and No/100-----
DOLLARS (\$ 4,200.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%)
per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, and

WHEREAS, the unpaid balance of said debt or debts, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable,

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 11 as shown on a plat prepared by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, dated July, 1942, entitled "Property of B. M. McGee Trust Estate", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book M at page 51, and also being known and designated as Lot No. 21 as shown on a plat prepared by C. M. Furman, Jr., dated April 19, 1921, entitled "Prop. of E. E. Watson", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book F at page 11, and having according to the first mentioned plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Spruce Street at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 10 and 11; ^{and turning} thence with the line of Lot No. 10 N. 72-0 E. 120 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 9; thence with the line of Lot No. 9 N. 18-0 W. 40 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 11 and 12; thence with the line of Lot No. 12 S. 72-0 W. 120 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Spruce Street; thence with the eastern side of Spruce Street S. 18-0 E. 40 feet the point of beginning.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to the mortgagor herein by deed of Gertrude Mosley, dated January 31, 1959 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Deed Book 616 at page 84.

Spruce Street is also known as Mack Street.
