NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Caroline E. Mason

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Bank of Travelers Rest, its successors and assigns forever,

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land with buildings and improvements thereon situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Saluda Township, containing 34 acres, more or less, beginning at a stone on Gap Creek at the joint corner of the 96-3/4 acre tract, lying on the South side of Gap Creek and now owned by Caroline E. Mason. This being the same property conveyed to Caroline E. Mason by S. V. Johnson, et al on October 25, 1959 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 397, at page 440.

ALSO: All that other piece, parcel or tract of land with buildings and improvements thereon situate in the County and State aforesaid in Cleveland Township and containing 96-3/4 acres, more or less, and being the same property conveyed to Caroline E.
