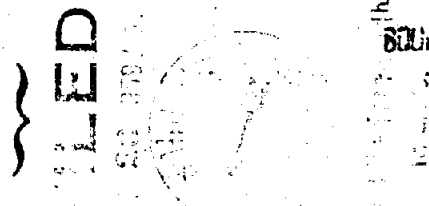

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I , the said Arthur M. Williams
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these
Presents, am well and truly indebted to Bank of Piedmont
in the full and just sum of (\$556.59) Five Hundred Fifty-six and 59/100
, to be paid Payable in eighteen monthly payments of
\$30.93 each beginning May 22, 1959

, with interest thereon from maturity
at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid in advance
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage
in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises
to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to
the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, that I , the said Arthur M. Williams
, in consideration of the said debt and
sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Bank of Piedmont
according to the terms of the said note, and also in
consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me , the said Arthur M. Williams
, in hand well and truly paid by the said Bank of Piedmont

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bar-
gained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bank of
Piedmont, its successors and assigns forever;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State
of South Carolina, situate and lying east of the Southern Railway tracks in the
Town of Piedmont, S. C. containing five (5) acres, more or less, and having
the following metes and bounds;

Beginning at iron stake or pin, thence N 43 E 7.59 chs. to an iron pin, thence
S 48 E 7.66 chs. to the corner of J. O. Jenkins line and the line of Mrs. Pearl
Gillespie to a stone; thence S 67 W 10.63 chains to an iron pin, thence N 9 1/4 W
4.20 chs. to the beginning corner.

This being a portion, part of land inherited by W. P. Nesbitt from his Father
C. D. Nesbitt and his Mother, Mrs. Sue Blakely Nesbitt and inherited by us from
W. P. Nesbitt.
