WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$ 8,800.00), with interest from date at the rate of five & one-fourth per centum (5 1/4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of General Mortgage Co. in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Forty-eight and 66/100ths----- Dollars (\$ 48.66), commencing on the first day of June, 1959, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of May, 1989.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southwestern side of Gardenia Drive in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 90 as shown on a plat prepared by T.J. McCoy, Surveyor, dated August 27, 1955, entitled "Cedar Lane Gardens", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book GG at page 139, and having according to said plat and also according to a more recent plat prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated April 22, 1959, entitled "Property of Guy D. White & Carolyn M. White", the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Gardenia Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 90 and 91, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 91 S. 56-12 W. 194.9 feet to an iron pin in the center of a ten-foot utility easement; thence along the center of said utility easement and line of Lots Nos. 98 and 99, N. 32-57 W. 70 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 89 and 90; thence with the line of Lot No. 89 N. 56-12 E. 193.9 feet to an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Gardenia Drive; thence with the Southwestern side of Gardenia Drive S. 33-48 E. 70 feet to the point of beginning.
