 bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
 South Carolina National Bank, Greenville, South Carolina, its suc-
 cessors and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being
 in Greenville County, South Carolina, on the northwest^{side} of Easy
 Street, known as Lot No. 55 and the adjoining one-half of Lot
 No. 54 on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by W. N. Willis, En-
 gineer, recorded in Plat Book Y at Page 23, and, according to
 said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of Easy Street,
 at the joint front corner of Lots 55 and 56, and running thence
 N. 37-55 W., 201 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 47 E., 65 feet
 to an iron pin in the center of the rear line of Lot No. 54;
 thence through the center of said lot No. 54, S. 43 E., 200
