TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

W.M. CARTEE

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto CAROLINA FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, Greenville, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Eight Thousand and No/100ths-----

DOLLARS (\$ 8,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six-----
per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, and

WHEREAS, the unpaid balance of said debt or debts, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable,

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being on the Eastern side of Briarcliff Drive (formerly Park Road), in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 2 of the property of William Goldsmith, a plat of which is recorded in Plat Book F at page 190, this plat is a resubdivision of Lots Nos. 3 and 4 of a subdivision known as East Overbrook, a plat of which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E at page 159, and having according to the first mentioned plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Briarcliff Drive at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, which point is 270 feet South from the Southeastern corner of the intersection of Spartanburg Road and Briarcliff Drive, and running thence N. 74-50 E. 183 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence S. 23-55 E. 50 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lots Nos. 2 and 3; thence with the line of Lot No. 3 S. 74-50 W. 183 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Briarcliff Drive; thence along the Eastern side of said drive N. 24-05 W. 50 feet to the point of beginning.
