All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina known and designated as lots Nos. 30, 31, and 32 as shown on a plat of T. W. Dill Estate made by S. C. Moon, Surveyor, October 1940, said plat recorded in the Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, said lots Nos, 30, 31 and 32 fronting each 50 feet on south dide of the Super Highway and running back in parellel lines to a depth of 200 feet. Said lots being situated about two and a half miles West of the city of Greer and being all of that propertyconveyed to us by deed of T. D. Elmore dated March 11, 1941 and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 234 page 9.

Also all that other piece, parcel or lot of land adjoining the above described property and being a part of lot No. 29 on above named Plat and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning on a stake on the southern edge of the Right of Way of the said Super Highway, joint corner of Lot No. 29 and of an offset in the said Right of Way, and runs thence with the said offset and the dividing line of lots 29 and 30, S.24-35 W. 86 feet to a stake on the said dividing line; thence a new line N. 16-00E 87.6 feet to a stake on the southern edge of the said Right of Way; thence with the southern edge of the said Right of Way N. 68.00 E 13 feet to the beginning corner.
