SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, _____, the said John R. Mitchell
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these
Presents, I am well and truly indebted to Bank of Piedmont
in the full and just sum of (\$773.19) Seven Hundred Seventy-three and 19/100
, to be paid Payable in twenty-four monthly payments of
\$32.22 each beginning June 7, 1959.

, with interest thereon from maturity
at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid in advance
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage
in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises
to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to
the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bar-
gained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bank of
Piedmont, its successors and assigns forever;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of
South Carolina, containing two and one tenth (2.1) acres, more or less, adjoining
lands of W. O. Turner, lands formerly belonging to W. P. Nesbitt and possibly
others having the following courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the Moonville Road at corner of W. O. Turner and running
thence along line of W. O. Turner, North 67 1/2 West, 8.00 chains to a Poplar;
thence S. 21 1/2 W. 2.25 to an iron pin, new corner; thence S. 57- E. 6.87 to a
point in Moonville road; thence along said road, N. 42 1/2 E. 3.65 to beginning corner.
