WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto THE INDEPENDENT LIFE AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Florida, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of **Sixty-Five Hundred and No/100** Dollars (\$ **6500.00**), with interest from date at the rate of **Six** per centum (**6 %**) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of The Independent Life and Accident Insurance Company in Jacksonville, Florida, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of **Fifty-Four and 86/100** Dollars (\$ **54.86**), commencing on the **15th** of **July**, 19 **39** and on the **15** day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of **Greenville**, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Greenville Township, on the Tindal Road (sometimes called Parker Road) containing 4.83 acres, more or less, and being more particularly described according to a recent survey prepared by C. C. Jones, Eng., as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of a bridge in Tindal Road, crossing Langston Creek, and running thence with the Creek as the line the following traverses, to-wit: N. 70-18 W. 153 feet, N. 66-46 W. 190 feet N. 29-51 W. 53.3 feet, N. 79-51 W. 121.7 feet and N. 74-51 W. 85 feet to point in center of said creek; thence N. 25-34 E. 411.8 feet to iron pin; thence S. 68 E. 563 feet to iron pin in the western edge of Tindal Road; thence S. 33-20 W. 424 feet to the point of beginning.

Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
