**MORTGAGE**

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA  
COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

Margaret Ford  
(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of **Three Thousand Three Hundred and No/100 -- DOLLARS (\$ 3,300.00**), with interest thereon from date at the rate of five and one-half per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Greenville Township, and being known and designated as Lot No. 46 of a Subdivision known as McCullough Heights as shown by Plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E, at page 95, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Verdun Avenue, joint corner of Lots Nos. 45 and 46, which point is 121 feet Southeast from the intersection of Donnybrook Avenue and Verdun Avenue, and running thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 45 and 46, S. 45-26 W. 180 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 44-20 E. 60 feet to iron pin, rear corner of Lots Nos. 46 and 47; thence with the line of Lot No. 47, N. 45-26 E. 180 feet to iron pin on South side of Verdun Avenue; thence along South side of Verdun Avenue, N. 44-20 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same premises conveyed to the Mortgagor by Deed recorded in Deed Book 212, at page 170, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
